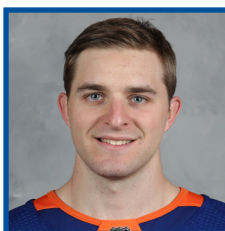

## PLAYERS TO WATCH



### JORDAN EBERLE #7

Jordan Eberle extended his post-season high point total with his eighth point of the post-season on Wednesday. Eberle has at least one point in six of the Islanders seven playoff games. On Wednesday, Eberle became just the second Islander in the last 26 years to record at least four goals and four assists in a single post-season.



### DEVON TOEWS #25

Islanders rookie, Devon Toews scored his first playoff goal on Wednesday night in Carolina. Toews, 25, leads all Islanders defenseman and ranks T-3rd among all NHL rookie blueliners with three points (1G, 2A) in seven games. The Abbotsford, BC native is one of four rookie defenseman to score a goal in the 2019 playoffs.



### JUSTIN WILLIAMS #14

Carolina captain, Justin Williams scored the game-winning goal for the Hurricanes halfway thru the third period on Wednesday. Williams, 37, is sitting at 99 points (38G, 61A) in 150 career playoff games. The Cobourg, ON native has five points (2G, 3A) in 10 playoff games this season.

## ISLANDERS vs. HURRICANES QUICK FACTS

### GAME 3 RECAP:

Carolina forward Justin Williams scored the game-winning goal with 9:45 remaining to help give the Hurricanes a 3-0 series lead. **Josh Bailey** and **Devon Toews** scored the goals for New York while **Jordan Eberle** & **Tom Kuhnhackl** added assists in the loss.

### FOR THE RECORD:

Islanders rookie defenseman, **Devon Toews** scored his first career playoff goal in Game 3, a power-play goal which opened the scoring for New York. With the goal, he became the first Islanders rookie to score a power-play goal since Alan Quine's 2-OT winner vs. Florida in 2016. **Ryan Pulock** scored in that same series, making Toews the first rookie defenseman to score a goal for the Islanders since 2016.

### ON THE PK:

The Islanders have not allowed a power-play goal in six-straight playoff games, establishing a new franchise record. The Islanders have killed off 19-of-20 penalties this post-season. The lone goal allowed by the penalty kill was in the second period of Game 1 vs Pittsburgh. The Islanders are the only team in the 2019 playoffs who have not allowed a power-play goal on the road.
