The Flyers and Blue Jackets combined for 30 goals in the season series last year.

The Flyers were 6-2-3 against Columbus in 11 games from the Blue Jackets' inception in 2000 through the end of the 2012-13 season. Since Columbus became a member of the Eastern Conference prior to the 2013-14 season, the Flyers have gone 6-12-7 against them in 25 games.

NOTES OF THE NIGHT

The Flyers are starting a run of four consecutive games against Metropolitan Division opponents with tonight's game. The Flyers are 1-0 so far in the division, having only played New Jersey on October 9. Every other team in the Metro has played at least four games against other teams in the division. The Flyers, Dallas and Chicago are the only teams that have played just one game in their division so far this year. The Flyers are looking to improve on a 10-16-2 record against the Metro last season.

The Flyers just completed a run of six consecutive games against Western Conference opponents. They now start a run of 13 in a row against the East. They won't see another Western Conference team until they host Calgary on November 23.

The Flyers are 57.5 percent on faceoffs as a team this season, which leads the league. **Sean Couturier** and **Claude Giroux** are each at 68.3 percent, which is tied for the league lead among 102 players who have taken at least 80 faceoffs. Couturier is at 82.3 percent (14-for-17) on the power play.

Forward **Joel Farabee** made his NHL debut on Monday vs. Vegas. He picked up his first NHL point on Thursday in Chicago with an assist. In that game, Farabee had a hand in two goals that were both disallowed after offsides challenges – he set up one by **Kevin Hayes** in the first period and scored one himself in the third.

Travis Konecny has has a point in seven of the eight games this season, including three multi-point games. He started a season with a four-game point streak, becoming the fourth-youngest Flyer to do so and the youngest since Eric Lindros in 1995-96.

In addition to setting the franchise record for youngest goalie to record a shutout on Oct. 9 vs. NJD, **Carter Hart** joined a list of just eight goaltenders to have a shutout in a Flyers uniform before their 23rd birthday; his shutout was only the 10th to fit that category, four of which came in the franchise's first year.

Hart already has appeared in more games under the age of 21 than any other Flyers goalie. He started this season at the age of 21 years, 50 days; every game he plays this season will add to his total games played as the youngest regular goalie in team history. The previous youngest goalie to appear in more than two games for the team was Dominic Roussel, who played 17 games in the 1991-92 season starting at the age of 21 years, 237 days.

Philadelphia Flyers: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Alain Vigneault

Alain Vigneault was named the 21st head coach in Flyers history on April 15, 2019.

Vigneault, 58, brings 1,216 games of experience as an NHL head coach to Philadelphia over parts of 16 seasons. He served as the head coach of the New York Rangers for five seasons (2013-18), the Vancouver Canucks for seven seasons (2006-13) and the Montreal Canadiens for parts of four seasons (1997-2000).

Vigneault has 's teams have won seven division championships and have made the playoffs 11 times, advancing past the first round on eight of those occasions, and reaching the Stanley Cup Final with Vancouver in 2010-11 and the Rangers in 2013-14. Three of Vigneault's teams have earned the Presidents' Trophy – Vancouver on two occasions, 2010-11 and 2011-12, and the Rangers in 2014-15. Individually, Vigneault won the Jack Adams Award as the NHL Coach of the Year in 2006-07 and was a finalist for the award on three other occasions, in 1997-98, 2010-11 and 2014-15.

BLUE JACKETS NOTES

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS

The Blue Jackets stretched their point streak to six-straight (4-0-2) with a 4-3 overtime win over Carolina on Thursday. The club improved to 20-8 in the 3-on-3 overtime session since 2017-18. Each of the Jackets' last eight games have been decided by a single goal (5-1-2). It's the club's second longest such streak in franchise history after playing in a franchise-record nine-straight one-goal games from Feb. 18-Mar. 7, 2013 (4-3-2). Columbus, which has played in four-straight games decided by overtime (2-2), previously reached on four occasions in franchise history, with the franchise-record being six-straight games spanning Dec. 9-20, 2014.

HOLD MY JACKET

Since starting the season with two losses, the Jackets are 5-1-2 in their past eight games, including an active six-game point streak (4-0-2). The Blue Jackets' 12 points since Oct. 7 are seventh-T in the NHL. The club recorded point streaks of six or more games on two occasions in 2018-19, going 5-0-2 from Nov. 4-17 and 6-0-1 from Dec. 13-27.

QUICK STOP AT THE METRO STATION

The Blue Jackets win over Carolina on Thursday was the first stop of a two-game divisional swing that sees the club play Philadelphia tonight. The Blue Jackets are 5-1-1 within the division since Mar. 15, 2019. Tonight's game at Philadelphia is the eighth of 11-straight outings from Oct. 11-Nov. 2 that rotate between home and road venues for the club. The Blue Jackets' Oct. 30 home game vs. Edmonton begins a stretch of six-straight vs. the Western Conference.

LIGHTS, CAM-ERA, ATKINSON

Cam Atkinson came through in a big way on Thursday vs. Carolina, scoring the game-winning goal in overtime to lift the Blue Jackets to victory. The goal was Atkinson's sixth career overtime game-winner and 39th game-winning goal of his career. The winger sits one OT goal behind Seth Jones for the franchise record and five GWGs behind Rick Nash for first on that list. Atkinson has 1-2-3 in his last four games and has fared well against Philadelphia over the past few years, with three multi-goal games (7-1-8) in his last five vs. Philly overall, including going 5-1-6 in his past three games in Philadelphia.

PIERRE-LUC PRODUCTIONS

Pierre-Luc Dubois had the crucial assist on Atkinson's OT goal on Thursday, after making a power move to evade a Carolina forward and enter the zone. The center has 4-2-6 in his last eight games, including goals in three-straight road games. Entering his third season, Dubois became the fastest Blue Jacket in history to record 100 points to start his career with the franchise (143 games). He has back-to-back 20-goal seasons and if he can reach that threshold this year, will become the first player in Blue Jackets history to begin his NHL career with three straight 20-goal seasons.

THE ONUS ON JOONAS

Joonas Korpisalo has started seven of the past eight games for the club and currently has picked up points in five-straight games for the Blue Jackets (4-0-1). His career-best point streak is seven contests, set to begin last season (Oct. 4-Nov. 10, 5-0-2). He is 4-1-1 with a 2.47 GAA and .915 SV pct. in his last six outings since Oct. 11. Korpisalo has faced the Flyers once in his career, making 30 saves on Dec. 19, 2015 to record his first NHL victory.

NIGHTLY DOSE OF NYQUIST

Gus Nyquist became the first player in CBJ history to score the overtime winner via penalty shot in Monday's win at Toronto. This past summer's free agent acquisition has 1-3-4 in his last six games and has recorded a point in all four road contests this season (2-2-4). Nyquist has a three-game point streak in Philadelphia (2-1-3) and points in five of his last six games (2-3-5) in the city of Brotherly Love.

THREE-WAY RACE TO PASS KLESLA

The Blue Jackets have a three-way race to become the highest scoring defenseman in franchise history. Seth Jones, David Savard and Zach Werenski have each scored 40 goals as Jackets, one short of the franchise record for career goals by a blueliner set by Rostislav Klesla (41).

THE 500 CLUB

David Savard (40-111-151, 499 GP) is set to play in his 500th career game with the Blue Jackets tonight, becoming the eighth player all-time to reach that mark after Nick Foligno (126-166-292, 500 GP) joined the list on Thursday. Cam Atkinson (537 GP) is the lone active Jacket in the club as he became the sixth member of the club last season (Feb. 12, 2019 vs. WSH).

Columbus Blue Jackets: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: John Tortorella

John Tortorella was named head coach of CBJ on 10/21/15. He has compiled a 627-496-144 record in 1,267 games during his NHL coaching career with TBL, NYR, VAN and CBJ. Tortorella's 1,267 games coached are 15th all-time in NHL history. His teams have qualified for the Stanley Cup Playoffs 11 times and he led TBL to the 2004 Stanley Cup.

The Boston native won his 2nd Jack Adams Award as NHL's Coach of the Year (1st in 2003-04 w/ TBL) after leading CBJ to the best season in club history in 2016-17 (50-24-8). He ranks 1st among U.S.-born coaches in all-time NHL wins and owns CBJ's franchise record in wins and games coached (181-121-29 in 331 games).

Internationally, Tortorella served as head coach for Team USA at the World Cup of Hockey 2016 and was an assistant coach with Team USA at the 2010 Olympic Games (silver). He also served as the squad's head coach at the 2008 World Championships and was an assistant coach at the 2005 World Championships.
