



Updated Policies and Procedures as of July 2020

- 1) All employees and customers must enter the facility through the main doors and **must wear a mask or face covering at all times**, except when on the ice.
- 2) There will be a check-in table set up at the front entrance of the building.
 - a) Skaters/coaches will be allowed to check-in no earlier than 15 minutes prior to their scheduled ice time.
 - b) All skaters (or a parent/guardian if the skater is under 18) will need to sign a waiver form.
 - c) Skaters 12 and under will be allowed inside the rink with 1 parent/guardian to help with skates. The parent/guardian must then exit the building once the skater is on the ice. Skaters 13 and older will not be permitted past the check-in table with anyone.
 - d) Anyone entering the facility will need to have their temperature checked – you will not be permitted if you have a temperature higher than 100.4 degrees.
 - e) Each skater will be given a number. This will be the chair/area number that they will use to get ready. They must remain in this area until it is time to enter the ice. At that time, they will take all of their belongings onto the ice (it is recommended that skaters come dressed and bring as little as possible to the rink – hockey bags will not be permitted – except for goalies). Locker rooms will not be available until further notice.
- 3) At the conclusion of each ice slot, skaters will exit the ice through the opposite door and may use the chair/area with their designated number on that side. They will then exit the building through that side as well. All participants must be out of the building 10 minutes following their ice time.
- 4) **Guests will need to abide by social distancing rules and stay six feet apart at all times**. We have placed stickers on the floor throughout the facility to help our guests maintain this distance. There will be **no congregating** of any kind allowed in the building.
- 5) Anyone not following these policies will be denied entry and/or asked to leave. Staff members will be stationed throughout the building to assist all customers.
