INVINCIBLE

Vincent Trocheck registered three points (2g, 1a) tonight, marking the 13th multi-goal game of his career and his first with the Hurricanes. Tonight's game marked the seventh time in his career that he scored two goals in a single period and just the second time that he scored two in the first (1/17/17 at CGY with FLA).

COMING IN PAIRS

Martin Necas and **Sebastian Aho** each posted two points tonight. Necas tallied two assists to tie his career-high for a single game (12/23/19 at TOR) and register his fifth career multi-point performance. Aho also posted two assists his 63rd career multi-point game and his 23rd career multi-assist game.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS

Through the first five games of 2020-21, Carolina has only allowed seven goals against, which marks the fewest goals against through the first five games of any season in franchise history. The previous low mark was nine, set by Hartford in 1994-95.

GOING BACK-TO-BACK

Tonight, Carolina opened their first of 11 sets of back-to-backs this season. Last season, the Hurricanes went 7-5-0 in the first game and 7-4-1 in the second game of back-to-backs.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina went 3-for-5 on the power play tonight and is now 6-for-21 (28.6%) on the man-advantage this season. The Hurricanes were 5-for-6 on the penalty kill and are now 16-for-18 (88.9%) on the kill this season.
- Dallas is 1-for-6 on the power play tonight and is now 11-for-25 (44.0%) on the man-advantage this season. The Stars are 2-for-5 on the penalty kill and are now 19-for-24 (79.2%) on the kill this season.
