5) **Sidney Crosby** tallied the shootout winner on Thursday against the Islanders. Crosby is now one of just 11 players in NHL history to record 40 or more shootout goals, while his 18 game-deciding shootout goals are tied for fifth-most in NHL history.

Not only is the Crosby/Ovechkin rivalry one of the NHL's best, but it's also one of the league's longest-standing rivalries. Crosby and Ovechkin are two of just eight players in the NHL to play for the same team since the beginning of the 2005-06 season along with **Patrice Bergeron** (BOS), **Dustin Brown** (LAK), **Ryan Getzlaf** (ANA), **Mark Giordano** (CGY), **Duncan Keith** (CHI) and **Brent Seabrook** (CHI). Only Bergeron and Brown played for their current teams prior to the '05-06 season.

WASHINGTON WHIPPERS

Penguins captain **Sidney Crosby** and **Evgeni Malkin** have consistently produced points throughout their careers against the Capitals. Despite not playing in the same division as Washington until 2013-14, the duo ranks first (tied) and third, respectively, in points versus the Capitals among all active players:

FULL STRENGTH

- For the first time since Jan. 19, the Capitals are expected to have a full lineup.
- Since Jan. 19, the Capitals are 4-3-1, and prior to and including Jan. 19, Washington was 2-0-2.
- Since Washington last had a full roster, the Capitals are tied for fourth in the NHL in goals per game (3.50) and rank first on the power play (42.1 percent).
- Nicklas Backstrom led the Capitals with 13 points (4g, 9a) during that span, which is tied for 12th in the NHL. Alex Ovechkin scored four goals in his four games during that span.
- The Capitals have had eight players appear in every game this year (Nicklas Backstrom, John Carlson, Zdeno Chara, Brenden Dillon, Nic Dowd, Carl Hagelin, Garnet Hathaway and Richard Panik). These eight players have combined for 19 goals and 51 points this season.
- Including the goaltenders, the Capitals have had 29 players play in a game this year. That's as many players that participated in a game last season. This year is also the first time the Capitals have used three goaltenders in a season (Craig Anderson, Ilya Samsonov, Vitek Vanecek) since 2014-15 (Philipp Grubauer, Braden Holtby, Justin Peters).
- The Capitals are one of four teams that have utilized 29 different players this season (Colorado, Edmonton and Los Angeles).
- Four Players have appeared in their first regular season game of their career this season (Philippe Maillet, Connor McMichael, Brian Pinho, Vitek Vanecek). This marks the ninth time in franchise history the Capitals have had four players make their debuts within the first 12 games of the season.
- The Capitals have had 18 players score a goal this season, tied for the second most in the NHL (Columbus: 20; Edmonton: 18).

- Backstrom recorded three points (1g, 2a) on Feb. 7 against the Philadelphia Flyers, his 82nd career game with at least three points and his 156th multi-assist game. Since 2007-08, Backstrom's first year in the NHL, he ranks second in multi-assist games (Sidney Crosby: 166) and fifth in three-point games.
- Backstrom is now five assists shy of 700 career assists, where he would become one of three active players to reach the 700 assist mark and the fifth Swedish-born player in NHL history, joining Nicklas Lidstrom (878), Henrik Sedin (830), Mats Sundin (785) and Daniel Alfredsson (713).
- Backstrom's 0.72 assists per game are tied for the second-most among active NHL players with at least 500 assists, and that is tied for the 17th-highest rate in NHL history among players with 500 assists.

ALL THAT POWER

- The Capitals are 10 for 27 on the power play in 12 games this season, good for a 37.0 power play percentage, which ranks first in the NHL.
- Six different Capitals have scored power play goals: John Carlson (3), Nicklas Backstrom (2), T.J. Oshie (2), Alex Ovechkin (1), Tom Wilson (1) and Richard Panik (1).

- John Carlson is one of two defensemen in the NHL with three power play goals this season (Florida's Aaron Ekblad) and his five power play points are tied for 11th in the NHL among defensemen.
- Since 2016-17, the Capitals' 22.0 power play percentage ranks sixth in the NHL.
- The Capitals are tied for 13th in power play goals (10) this season, despite having the lowest average power play opportunities per game in the NHL (2.25).

BIG WILLY

- Tom Wilson recorded four points (1g, 3a) in game against the Philadelphia Flyers on Feb. 7. It marked the first three assist game of his career and his second career four point game (2g, 2a on Dec. 6, 2017 against the Chicago Blackhawks).
- Wilson's four point effort pushed him to 200 career points (83g, 117a).
- Wilson's 12 points this season (5g, 7a) are tied with Alex Ovechkin for the second most on the Capitals.
- This season marks Wilson's second-best 10-game start of his career, second only to his 14 points (8g, 6a) in 10 games in 2018-19, when Wilson finished with 40 points (22g, 18a) in 63 games.
- Currently, Wilson is averaging 1.20 points per game, nearly double his career best season of points per game (0.65 points per game in 2019-20).
- Wilson has nine penalty minutes in 10 games (0.90 penalty minutes per game). He has never averaged less than 1.36 penalty minutes per game in a single season.
- Wilson's 42 hits rank second on the Capitals (Garnet Hathaway: 45) and ranks 12th in the NHL through games played Feb. 12.

JUSTIN TIME

- Justin Schultz is expected to return to the Capitals lineup today against the Pittsburgh Penguins after missing four games due to injury and for the first time since Jan. 28 against the New York Islanders.
- Prior to being injured, Schultz averaged 18:45 of ice time and recorded six points (2g, 4a) in eight games.
- Schultz recorded three straight multi-point games (2g, 4a) from Jan. 24-28 for the first time in his career.
- Schultz is currently tied with Evgeny Kuznetsov for fifth on the Capitals in points per game this season (0.75).
- Schultz's 80.0 on-ice goals for percentage at even strength leads the Caps (12 on ice goals for, 3 against), and his 12 on-ice goals for are tied for third on the team.
- Additionally, Schultz's 53.7 shot attempt percentage at five-on-five (116 shot attempts for, 100 against) ranks first on the Capitals among players with at least eight games played.

SUPER CARLY

- John Carlson is tied for seventh among NHL defensemen in points (11) through games played Feb. 12.
- Carlson recently passed Dale Hunter (375) for the fifth-most assists in franchise history and now sits at 380 assists, 12 assists shy of Mike Gartner (392) for the fourth most assists in franchise history.
- Carlson is 11 points shy of 500 points. He could become one of 10 active defensemen to reach the milestone.
- Carlson is now five goals shy of passing both Mike Green (113) and Calle Johansson (113) for the third-most goals in franchise history by a defenseman.
- During the 2019-20 season, Carlson set personal highs for points (15g, 60a) and assists in a season, leading all NHL defensemen in both respective categories.
- Carlson's 60 assists last season were one shy of tying the franchise record for the most by a defenseman in a single season (Scott Stevens, 1988-89: 61a), and his 75 points were six shy of the record (Larry Murphy, 1986-87: 81).
