-- Jordan Staal scored two goals tonight to extend his goal/point streak to three games (2/11-2/15: 4g, 1a), and he has now scored five goals in his last five games (2/7-2/15).

-- Brock McGinn registered his first two assists of the season tonight.

-- Jake Bean tallied two assists tonight for his first two career NHL/Hurricanes points and his first career multi-point game.

-- Teuvo Teravainen posted four points (1g, 3a) tonight for his 66th career multi-point game (60th with Carolina) and his fifth four-point game. He has now scored goals in back-to-back games (2/13-2/15: 2g, 3a).

-- Jake Gardiner tallied an assist tonight and he has now posted three in his last two games (2/13-2/15).

-- Martin Necas tallied an assist tonight, and he has now posted an assist in back-to-back games (2/13-2/15).

-- Vincent Trocheck scored a goal tonight to extend his point streak to three games (2/11-2/15: 1g, 3a).

-- Andrei Svechnikov recorded an assist tonight to extend his assist streak to three games (2/11-2/15: 3a).

OPTIMUS REIM

James Reimer made a season-high 37 saves tonight to earn his seventh win of the season. In his last 21 regular season games with the Hurricanes, he is 15-2-2 with a 2.86 goals-against average, a .905 save percentage and two shutouts. Since joining Carolina at the beginning of the 2019-20 season, he has posted a 21-7-2 record, and his .733 points percentage ranks second among all NHL goaltenders during that span, trailing only Tuukka Rask (.740).

GO FISH

Sebastian Aho scored his fourth goal of the season tonight. His 13 points (4g, 9a) are tied with **Andrei Svechnikov** (6g, 7a) and **Vincent Trocheck** (6g, 7a) for the second-most on the team this season, trailing only **Jordan Staal** (6g, 8a). Aho led the Hurricanes with 66 points (38g, 28a) in 68 games last season. He has now posted 274 career NHL/Hurricanes points (124g, 150a), trailing only Eric Staal (164-194—368) for the most by a player in his first five NHL seasons in team history (since relocation).

BROCK 'N' ROLL

Brock McGinn registered four points (2g, 2a) tonight, marking his 15th career multi-point game and his fifth career multi-goal game. His four points tonight tied his career high for a single game (1/14/17 at NYI: 1g, 3a). He is tied with **Nino Niederreiter** and **Vincent Trocheck** (7) for the team-lead in goals this season, with all seven of his goals coming in his last eight games. He recorded a career-long, four-game goal streak from 2/4-2/11.

THE FINNISH CONNECTION

Sebastian Aho and **Teuvo Teravainen** combined for six points (2g, 4a) tonight, and they each earned an assist on **Brock McGinn's** goal in the second period. They each contributed to the same goal 33 times in 2019-20, and at least one of them registered a point on 96 of Carolina's 217 goals (44.2%) last season.

WELCOME PAQUETTE

Cedric Paquette made his Hurricanes debut tonight. The Hurricanes acquired Paquette from the Ottawa Senators along with Alex Galchenyuk in exchange for Ryan Dzingel on 2/13. Paquette recorded one goal in nine games with the Senators this season. He previously registered 86 points (48g, 38a) in 386 games with Tampa Bay, adding three assists in 25 playoff games to help the Lightning to a Stanley Cup championship in 2019-20.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina went 2-for-2 on the power play tonight and is now 12-for-43 (27.9%) on the man-advantage this season. The Hurricanes were 3-for-3 on the penalty kill and are now 38-for-47 (80.9%) on the kill this season.
- Columbus went 0-for-3 on the power play tonight and is now 7-for-45 (15.6%) on the man-advantage this season. The Blue Jackets were 0-for-2 on the penalty kill and are now 27-for-37 (73.0%) on the kill this season.
