- Jordan Staal scored a goal tonight to extend his goal/point streak to four games (2/11-2/17: 5g, 1a).
- Sebastian Aho scored a goal tonight and has now scored a goal in back-to-back games (2/15-2/17: 2g, 1a).
- Brock McGinn recorded an assist tonight and has now posted points in six of his last seven games (2/4-2/17: 6g, 3a).
- Vincent Trocheck scored a goal tonight to extend his point streak to four games (2/11-2/17: 1g, 4a).
- Andrei Svechnikov tallied an assist tonight to extend his assist streak to four games (2/11-2/17: 4a).

FAMILIAR FACES

Vincent Trocheck scored a power-play goal tonight, in his first game against the Panthers since being traded by Florida on 2/24/20. After posting two points (1g, 1a) in seven games with Carolina in 2019-20, he now ranks tied for second on the team with 14 points (7g, 7a) through his first 13 games this season. Trocheck was acquired by the Hurricanes in exchange for Erik Haula, Eetu Luostarinen, Chase Priskie and Lucas Wallmark. Luostarinen and Gustav Forsling also faced Carolina for the first time since being acquired by Florida. Luostarinen made his NHL debut with the Hurricanes on 11/7/19 vs. NYR and tallied one assist in eight games with the team last season, while Forsling recorded 26 points (8g, 18a) in 57 AHL games with Charlotte in 2019-20.

RIVALRY REIGNITED

The Hurricanes and Panthers played their first of eight matchups as Central Division opponents tonight. This season marks the first year in which they have played in the same division since 2012-13, when they were both members of the Southeast Division. Carolina holds a 44-25-5-9 record against Florida when the two teams are in the same division, including a 28-7-2-2 record at PNC Arena. The Hurricanes' 44 wins against the Panthers were their second-most against any Southeast Division foe, trailing only ATL/WPG (46).

THAT ESCALATED QUICKLY

Jordan Staal and **Sebastian Aho** scored at 18:28 and 18:50 of the first period, respectively. This is the second time in as many games that the Hurricanes have scored two goals in a span of 27 seconds or less. **Brock McGinn** and **Teuvo Teravainen** scored at 1:29 and 1:56 of the second period, respectively, against CBJ on 2/15.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina went 1-for-3 on the power play tonight and is now 13-for-46 (28.3%) on the man-advantage this season. The Hurricanes went 3-for-4 on the penalty kill and are now 40-for-51 (78.4%) on the kill this season.
- Florida went 1-for-4 on the power play tonight and is now 12-for-41 (29.3%) on the man-advantage this season. The Panthers went 2-for-3 on the penalty kill and are now 32-for-42 (76.2%) on the kill this season.
