## Updated Policies and Procedures

Effective: 4/27/2021

- All employees and customers must enter the facility **through the main doors** and **must wear a mask or face covering at all times.**
  - o Skaters may take it off only while on the ice (except for Learn to Skate classes)
- There is a check-in table set up at the front entrance of the building.
  - o Skaters/coaches will be allowed to check-in no earlier than 15 minutes prior to their scheduled ice time.
  - o All skaters (or a parent/guardian if the skater is under 18) will need to sign a waiver form.
  - o **All locker rooms remain closed at this time.** Each skater can use a chair set up inside the rink to put skates on/off. These chairs are spaced 6 feet apart. It is recommended that all skaters/players come as dressed as possible – skates/helmet can be put on inside the rink. Reminder: participants are only allowed inside 15 minutes before their ice time.
  - o **Effective April 27, 2021: For all hockey and figure skating programs, each skater/player is allowed ONE PARENT/GUARDIAN to accompany them into the rink. This person may remain in the rink for the duration of the ice slot, but MUST sit in the participants designated chair.**
  - o Anyone allowed to enter the facility will need to have their temperature checked – you will not be permitted if you have a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher.
- We ask that all participants, parents and coaches exit the building within 10 minutes of the conclusion of their ice slot.
- **Everyone that is permitted inside will need to abide by social distancing rules and stay six feet apart at all times.** There will be **no congregating** of any kind allowed in the building.

**Anyone not following these policies will be denied entry and/or asked to leave. Staff members will be stationed throughout the building to enforce all of the above policies.**
