BLUE JACKETS NOTES

OPENING NIGHT FIREWORKS

The Blue Jackets kicked off their 21st season with an 8-2 victory over Arizona on Thursday. The club recorded multiple goals in all three periods (2, 3, 3) for the 17th time in franchise history and the first time since Apr. 16, 2019 (7-4 win in Game 4 of ECQF vs. Tampa Bay). The team set franchise records for the most goals scored and largest victory in a season opener in CBJ history. CBJ saw 13 players hit the scoresheet with seven of them picking up multi-point efforts.

ENTERING THEIR 21st SEASON

Columbus enters its 21st NHL season with an 82-game schedule in 2021-22, 41 home and 41 road games. The Jackets completed their 20th NHL season with a 18-26-12 record (48 pts), finishing eighth in the Central Division and 28th overall in the NHL.

STREAK SNAPPED

Last season marked the club's second sub-.500 season in the past nine campaigns and snapped its streak of consecutive appearances in the Stanley Cup Playoffs at four (2017-20). CBJ were one of three teams to make the Stanley Cup Playoffs over that span, joining Boston and Washington. Since 2012, the Blue Jackets have gone 337-257-73 (.560) and rank 15th in the NHL in wins during that time.

BACK IN THE METRO

The club returns to the Metropolitan Division for the 2021-22 campaign, after spending the shortened 2020-21 season in the Central Division. The Metropolitan Division consists of the Carolina Hurricanes, Pittsburgh Penguins, New Jersey Devils, New York Rangers, New York Islanders, Philadelphia Flyers and Washington Capitals. The last time CBJ were in the Metro was the 2019-20 season, where they finished sixth in the Metropolitan Division, ninth in the Eastern Conference and 14th overall in the NHL with a 33-22-15 record (81 pts).

OPENING AT HOME

The Blue Jackets open 2021-22 with two-straight home games, Oct. 14 (Arizona) and Oct. 16 (Seattle). Thursday's game marked the 14th season opener at home in 21 campaigns. The last time the Blue Jackets opened the season at home was on October 4, 2019 vs. Toronto (4-1 L). The team has won its first two home games of a season on five occasions, last accomplishing the feat in 2017-18. Last year, the Blue Jackets earned points in their first four home games for the first time in franchise history (2-0-2). The club plays five of its first six contests of the campaign at Nationwide Arena.

OCTOBER BREAKDOWN

The Blue Jackets will play eight games in the month of October, including five at Nationwide Arena. The Jackets play Seattle on Oct. 16, marking the first-ever meeting between the squads. Columbus will play their first road game against the Detroit Red Wings on Oct. 19. Overall, CBJ will face four division opponents this month (NYI, CAR, NYR, NJD).

The Blue Jackets honored the memory of goaltender Matiss Kivlenieks on Opening Night. Members of his family participated in a ceremonial puck drop prior to the game, while a banner featuring his number "80" was unveiled and will remain in the Nationwide Arena rafters for the duration of the season. His number "80" will also be visible in the ice behind both nets for Thursday's game vs. Arizona and Saturday's contest vs. Seattle. All CBJ players will wear an "80" sticker on their helmets throughout the season. In addition, all CBJ Foundation fundraising efforts from Thursday's game benefited the Matiss Kivlenieks Memorial Fund to support youth hockey initiatives in Columbus and his native Latvia.

CHANGES BEHIND THE BENCH

For the first time since 2015, CBJ won't have John Tortorella running the bench. The club and coach mutually parted ways at the end of last season. Brad Larsen was named the eighth head coach in club history on June 10 after previously serving as an assistant coach with the franchise for seven seasons from 2014-21. He is joined by new assistants, associate coach Pascal Vincent and assistant coach Steve McCarthy. Vincent spent the previous 10 years in the Winnipeg organization (last five as AHL head coach with Manitoba) while McCarthy served as an assistant coach with the Blue Jackets' AHL affiliate Cleveland Monsters since 2016. With Thursday's win, Larsen became the fourth person to earn a victory in his debut behind the bench in franchise history.

O CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

On Tuesday, Boone Jenner was named the seventh captain in team history along with alternate captains, Zach Werenski, Oliver Bjorkstrand and Gustav Nyquist. Jenner enters his ninth NHL/CBJ season having recorded 121-119-240 in 530 games. He ranks among the franchise's top-10 career leaders in numerous categories, including hits (1,291, 2nd), shots (1,261, 3rd), goals (4th), game-winning goals (20, 4th), points (6th) and power play goals (21, 8th). In the 2020-21 season, he tallied 8-9-17 and six penalty minutes in 41 appearances. Jenner previously served as one of the club's alternate captains from 2015-2021. In Thursday's season opener, he scored his first goal of the season, which was the eventual game-winner in the second period. It marked his 21st career game-winning tally.

"THE MAESTRO"

Forward Oliver Bjorkstrand started the 2021-22 season off with a bang on Thursday, setting a new single-game career high and tying the record for points in a season opener (Nash, Oct. 5, 2007) with four points (2-2-4). He previously collected three points on five occasions (MR: 2-1-3 on May 5, 2021 vs. Nashville). In 2020-21, he led the club in goals, assists points and multi-point efforts with 18-26-44 and 10 multi-point efforts while playing in all 56 games.

SILLY'S DEBUT

Blue Jackets rookie Cole Sillinger notched his first career point with an assist in his NHL debut on Thursday vs. Arizona. He was drafted by Columbus

12th overall in the 2021 NHL Draft and was one of two 18-year-olds to make opening day rosters (ANA's Mason McTavish). He is the sixth 18-year-old – and fourth youngest - to make his NHL debut with the Blue Jackets, joining Rostislav Klesla (2000), Rick Nash (2002), Dan Fritsche (2003), Gilbert Brule (2005) and Nikita Filatov (2008).

NEW JACKETS

Columbus has plenty of new faces on its bench. Gregory Hofmann joined Sillinger in those that made his NHL debut in his first game. The 28-year-old was acquired in a trade from Carolina off-season and signed a contract with the club after playing 12 years in the NLA in Switzerland. Meanwhile, defensemen Jake Bean (acquired in trade from CAR) and Adam Boqvist (acquired in trade from CHI) along with Dublin, Ohio native Sean Kuraly (signed as free agent from BOS) made their CBJ debuts on Thursday.

Columbus Blue Jackets: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Brad Larsen

Brad Larsen was named the 8th head coach in CBJ history on June 10, 2021 after previously serving as an assistant coach with the club for the past seven seasons.

The Nakusp, British Columbia native, under Todd Richards and John Tortorella, helped CBJ post a 269-208-49 record with a .557 point percentage in 536 games since being named an assistant coach on June 16, 2014. During that time, CBJ posted 5 winning seasons.

Larsen spent 2 seasons as head coach of the AHL's Springfield Falcons from 2012-14, leading the club to 2 of the 3 division titles won by a CBJ affiliate in franchise history. Springfield's 95-45-11 record and .655 points percentage from 2012-14 ranked 2nd in the AHL during that span, trailing only Texas (91-40-27, .667).

Larsen played 12 seasons as a forward in the NHL and AHL between 1997-2010. He registered 19-29-48 with 134 PIM in 294 career NHL games with Colorado Avalanche and Atlanta and was a member of Colorado's 2001 Stanley Cup championship team.

- Entering play Wednesday, **Larsson's** 605 career games played ranks eighth among players selected in the 2011 NHL Draft and third among defensemen taken that year, trailing only Minnesota's Jonas Brodin (608) and New Jersey's Dougie Hamilton (607).
- Among Seattle's active roster, only **Alex Barré-Boulet, Mark Giordano, Yanni Gourde** and **Brandon Tanev** went undrafted in the NHL Draft.
- **Giordano** leads all active, undrafted players in both career assists (367) and points (510). His 951 games played and 143 career goals ranks second and fourth, respectively, among active, undrafted skaters.
